



Instructions

1. Print out enough booklets for each child to have one.
2. Make an exemplar in advance so the children know what they're aiming for.
3. Let the coloring commence! For older children, you may invite them to add more imagery as they learn about each disciple.
 - a. You may choose to play the song that goes with this booklet: "Twelve Disciples Song" by Bigsby © 2011. On YouTube at: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tnAjDIW3If8>
4. When you are finished coloring, fold the paper in half lengthwise (hotdog fold).
5. Use scissors to cut along the dotted lines. Warning: Do not cut past where the dotted lines are or your book won't fold properly.
6. Fold the book along each of the solid lines. Hint: Fold both toward and away and crease it for best results.
7. Unfold the paper so it is a whole sheet and refold it lengthwise (hotdog).
8. Grab each end and gently push toward the center. The center pages (2 & 3 and 6 & 7) should push out to make an "X." Warning: Little children will need help with this step.
9. Find the cover of the book and press the pages to make it into book shape.

The 12 Disciples of Jesus


Matthias replaced Judas

These are the twelve that Jesus knew. He sent them out with things to do. Some, they believed; some took their time believing all he said was true. Oh, Jesus, I believe in You.






Judas (Iscariot) who betrayed Jesus
